QFTH Retreat Policy for Services and Merchandise Sale

It has come to our attention that we could be putting the property tax-exempt status of Seabeck in jeopardy and we certainly do not want to do that. These are our policies for services offered and selling merchandise at the retreats.

Someone Offering Retreat Participants a Service:

When we have a masseuse, a sewing machine repairman, the painter, or anybody else who comes to offer us a service, we will be running their fees through our books. So that means that individuals will make a check out for the amount owing to Quilts from the Heart (QFTH) and a Quilts from the Heart check will be made for the total amount owing to the service provider.

Who is Eligible to Provide a Service at Retreat:

The retreat coordinator will decide who the service providers will be at each retreat.

Selling Merchandise at Retreat

Because of Seabeck's policy, we cannot allow QFTH members to sell anything for personal gain at retreat. If a sale of merchandise solely benefits QFTH, as a non-profit, then Seabeck will allow the sale.
